Pro Log rolling tournament headed to La Crosse this Summer

The 2025 La Crosse Open is moving to Pettibone Park in La Crosse this year, and the professional tournament kicks off this Saturday, June 21st. The event is free of charge.

This year's La Crosse Open will feature some of the top pro rollers in the world, including Six-time women's world champion, and Holmen, WI native Livi Pappadopoulos. La Crosse natives Connor Birdsong and Shane Burns will be competing on the men's side, as will men's big names:

California's Tanner Hallett, Three-time world champion Anthony Polentini, and 18-year old standout and reigning #1 seed Marcus Heineck. Overall, more than 20 pros will be competing this year. Youth rollers, several from the La Crosse area, will be competing at the amateur event, scheduled to begin upon completion of the pro tournament.
